The monthly competition for the 2023-2024 year will be both digital and print images. The digital image competition will be via Zoom and Competition Assistant. Print competitions will be held at:

For DPI competitions we ask members to upload images to Competition Assistant. Details are below.

Club and judge interaction during the competition will be done thru Zoom. The zoom session will be used for the general club meeting, judging images and for comments from judges during critiques.

The Zoom meeting address will be sent out monthly in advance of the meeting/competition. *Watch for that.*

To get the best experience watching the competition we suggest that members login to the Competition Assistant, just as you will do to upload images. Details for getting access to the competition are below. The tutorial below covers logging in to upload images for CACCA individual competitions. OUR PROCESS IS VERY SIMILAR.

Some details are below as we talk about image upload.

The Competition Season:

The club competition year begins in October and runs thru May. We will alternate Dpi and Print competitions. There will be two competitions, Color and Monochrome. There will be two classes per competition (B & A).

A few words about the three competitions.

COLOR:

Color

Any General Subject

Images may include as the Main Subject:

Landscape, Travel, Architecture, Street, Portrait, Sports, Abstract, Photojournalism, Non-Nature Macros, Nature, wildlife, Still Life, Creative, and Everything Else.

MONOCHROME:

Mono (any subject). Images must be Monochrome (black & white, or sepia, selenium toned, Infra-red or similar)

No color or partial color images will be allowed. Any subject area is acceptable.

You may enter four images per your class each month two for color and two for Monochrome with a total of four images. Makeups are allowed.

Your class has been set based on previous year's standings. To be eligible for year end standing in a particular class one will need a full complement of eight images in color and eight images in monochrome.

Images are to be, as previously, no larger than **1400 pixels wide and 1050 pixels tall**,

which include the border. This is the same as previous DPI requirements, including; sRGB color space; 8 bit and in jpg format.

Image Uploading to Competition Assistant

The new CACCA judging system is called Competition Assistant. It is a web based program by 411-Vision. Some versions of Safari on Mac are unable to upload images. If that is the case, Chrome on the Mac will work.

The base website is www.411-vision.com

Uploading images is done by logging into the site and using Competition Assistant tools to upload images for each month's competition. Prepare your images as you prefer. The size requirements for images are unchanged from last year. Images should be jpg file type and sRGB color space. During the uploading dialog you will enter an image title. The filename is apparently no longer important to the competition process.

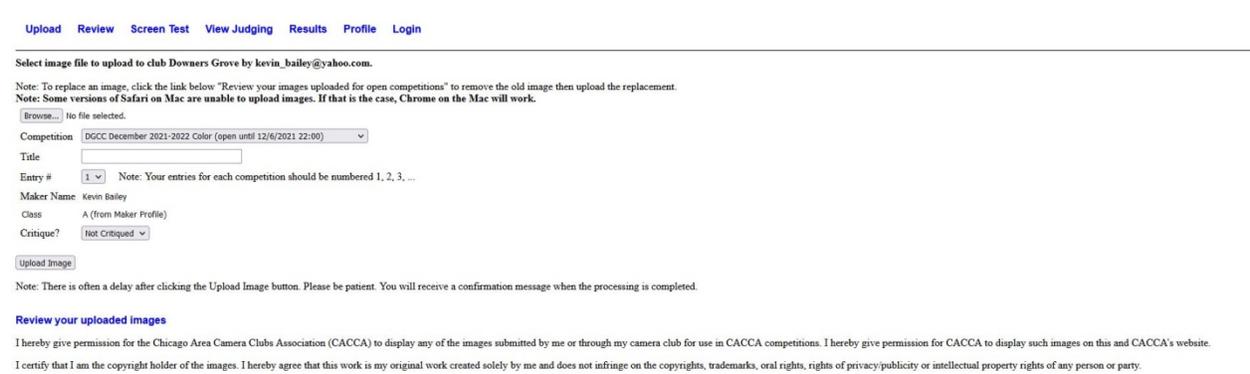
Select the club hosting the competition.

Browse to select the image desired

Enter a title as desired

Press upload

The image review will show the uploaded image.

Select Upload from the menu to continue with the next image.

Repeat for other images.

You may review the images you have uploaded at any time. Use the Review menu option.

On Competition Night - Viewing the competition

You will want to login to the Zoom meeting for general meeting words and to hear the conversations and then open another browser tab to open Competition Assistant. It is possible some browsers will work better than others for you.

Login to the Competition Assistant webpage as above. Select View Judging from the menu bar.

The available competitions will be listed in a drop down menu. (There may be some delay with items appearing in the menu.) Select and continue until you have a black screen. Relax and enjoy. Exit the viewer and select the next competition. Some details may be mentioned in the Zoom meeting .
